- It needs a little more functions for filtering
- Not sure if it's known by all who could need it
- The website has periods with very little activity or few updates.
- Not everybody are linked
- It is user-driven and the amount of users seems to be very limited.
- If there could come some monthly update or notification of there are "these" new informations etc. weakest part must be too silent
- No general news
- E.g. I get "Research" and "Logistics" confused. The first is just a calendar and the latter is more of a list of logistics available for research.
- Science
- The updates on consultancies. Seems they are not willing to share that information. Also education news and research stories could be updates more regularly
